BOAT RAMP SIGNAGE PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Rivergrove City Council at or shortly after 7:00 PM on November 14, 2022, via Zoom will meet and consider adopting an ordinance regulating the use of the Stark Community Boat Ramp. The City Council's decision will be based on what is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Rivergrove. The Council will take public testimony on this matter and testimony will be limited to 3 minutes per person.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 90-2022 AND SUGGESTED SIGNAGE

ORDINANCE 90-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERGROVE REGULATING ACTIVITY AT THE RIVERGROVE CITY PARK AND RIVER ACCESS

WHEREAS, the City is the owner and manager of the Lloyd Minor Park (the "Park") with access to the Tualatin River at the Stark Community Boat Ramp (the "River Access"); and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that use of the Park and River Access can have impacts on neighbors and City resources; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt regulations to control the operation and use of the River Access to protect the City's property, the neighbors of the Park and to control access to the Tualatin River,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF RIVERGROVE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. The City hereby adopts the regulations to control the use of the River Access as set forth in the language of the sign attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A. Section 2. The City directs City staff to have a sign with the language from Exhibit A created and posted at the River Access to the Tualatin River.

SUGGESTED SIGN LANGUAGE TO BE ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE

Ramp Operating Hours

Summer May 1 - October 31 8 AM - 9 PM
Winter November 1 - April 31 8 AM - 8 PM
Please return to the ramp by closing. Gates will close on time.
Gates will remain open during operating hours.

Welcome to the Stark Community Boat Ramp! To make your visit more enjoyable and safer, please comply with the following regulations:

The ramp has limited capacity. If it is crowded, please consider using the nearby parks with river access, exit points, and restroom facilities:

Brown's Ferry Park, or Tualatin Community Park with (Q-code showing location of other ramps)

Please be respectful of this residential area by not creating loud noises, not using portable speakers, and removing your trash and debris.

This compact ramp is best for small vessels, such as kayaks, canoes, and paddle boards. Large boats and trailers are not recommended due to the ramp size and the abrupt end-of-ramp drop-off.

Be courteous, and please have only one group at a time launching or retrieving watercraft from the ramp.

All other ramp uses, such as swimming, fishing, wading, etc. should promptly and courteously give way to launching and retrieving watercraft.

Be aware that there is no Lifeguard on duty, and there are no public restrooms.

Be aware of water temperature and velocity. Please use lifejackets.

Please adhere to the following safety regulations:

Do not park on the ramp or on yellow street curbs

Do not block traffic, mailboxes, or driveways

Tables, fires, or cooking on the ramp are not permitted

Smoking, vaping, alcohol, or fireworks are not permitted

Personal watercraft and towing a person behind a motorized boat are prohibited by State law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT a public hearing will be held by the Rivergrove Planning Commission at or shortly after 7:00 PM on Monday, November 21, 2022, via Zoom (see invitation on following page) to consider the following request:

Request: A Type III Conditional Use Permit and Development Permit to demolish an existing single-family home and construct a new dwelling on the property.

Applicant: Curt and Jan Taylor Location: 5036 Dogwood Drive

The public hearing on this matter will be conducted pursuant to the rules of procedure adopted by the Planning Commission. Oral and written testimony in favor of or in opposition to the request will be received during the hearing. Written comments may be submitted prior to the hearing by mailing to Heather Kibbey, City Manager/Recorder, City of Rivergrove P.O. Box 1104, Lake Oswego, OR 97035 or at manager@cityofrivergrove.com no later than 3 P.M. November 21, 2022. The decision to approve or deny the application will be based on compliance with the following ordinance criteria:

-- Rivergrove Land Development Ordinance (RLDO) Article 4 Sec. 4.010-4.110 Review Procedures; Article 5 Sec. 5.010-5.100 Residential Zone, Sec. 5.020 Flood Hazard District, Article 6 Sec. 6.300-6.340

-- Ordinance 70-2001 Rivergrove Flood Ordinance

Copies of the application information can be obtained at cost and are available for review by contacting the City Manager/Recorder, at 503-639-6919. Any questions regarding the application should also be addressed to the City Manager/Recorder. A staff report will be available for inspection on or about November 14, 2022 (contact the City Manager/Recorder to see the report or obtain a copy provided at cost).

Issues regarding compliance with pertinent code standards may provide the basis for an appeal to the City Council and shall be raised and submitted before the record is closed. Issues must be raised with sufficient specificity to enable the Planning Commission to respond to the issue. Failure to raise an issue in person or by letter, or failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the decision-maker an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes appeal to City Council on that issue.

In addition, failure to raise constitutional or other issues relating to proposed conditions of approval, with sufficient specificity to allow the Planning Commission to respond to the issue, precludes an action for damages in circuit court.

The Planning Commission shall review the application under a Type III procedure and make a decision according to the applicable criteria specified above. This hearing may be continued without additional published notices. All interested persons are invited to attend and be heard.
